# Ryan Sanapda U-14 Boys Inter-zonal Football Champions

**NAVI MUMBAI:** Overcoming a first half goal deficit Ryan International School, Sanpada (CBSE) u-14 boys' defeated a spirited Ryan International School, Chembur (ICSE) by a margin of 3-1 to regain the Ryan Inter-school Inter-zonal Football tournament last week.

The summit clash of the knock-out tourney which was hosted by St. Lawrence High School Vashi saw a steady and a compact approach both at the back and upfront by Ryan Chembur players in the first half against the defending champions. The tactic paid dividend as they took the lead despite their opponents eagerness to dominate the tie early on. It was their left winger Sushant Shetty who made the best of an opportunity after an assist by Soham Balwant off a Devraj Nandgaonkar long range throw-in. Sushant in one swoop inside the 18 yard box, found the back of the net past the Sanpada goalkeeper Ayush Singh. Stung by the unexpected goal, Ryan Sanpada's numerous attempts to find the equaliser was cut short by the agile Ryan Chembur custodian Ayush Gupta which ensured the visitors maintain the narrow lead at the half time whistle.

Piyush Sawant's Ryan Sanpada side decision to replace their first choice goalkeeper with Mihir Kalam was justified by the substitute goalie with an impressive save soon after the change of ends. Undeterred by the handful of attempts, the local favourites which had reached the finals of the u-14 Navi Mumbai District Subroto Cup recently, turned the tables with three quick goals in the final ten minutes of the second half. Winger Chirag Khilnani who had scored four in his of his team's 5-0 win over St. Joseph High School (CBSE), Panvel in the

had made a brilliant run from the right flank before turning in a pass across the face of the goal in the narrowest of angles. Chirag was once again in thick of action and a sole effort by him just outside the 18 yard box found the target

Earlier in the semis Ryan Sanpada had registered comprehensive 5-0 win over Ryan International School, Kharghar (ICSE) after leading 3-0 at half time. Vedant Nalawade who

opened the scoring along with Yash Bhor scored twice each, while Chirag Khilnani completed the tally for the Sanpada based team. On the other hand Ryan Chembur overcame a two goal deficit (trailed 1-3 at one stage) against Ryan International School, Nerul (ICSE) and tied the match at 3-3 at the end of regulation time. In the resulting penalties, Ryan Chembur won by an margin of 4-2 post and three sensational saves by their custodian Ayush Gupta under the post.

### Prevent the rupee value from falling

There is increasing demand for the U.S. dollar. Emerging market economies' currencies resume their prolonged slide against the U.S. dollar. The Indian rupee weakened past the 71 mark for the first time ever. This makes the rupee the worst-performing currency in Asia. Turkish lira, the Argentine peso and the South African rand, have suffered much larger losses.

The common factor underlying the wider carnage among emerging market currencies is the increasing demand for the dollar across the globe. Investors who earlier put their money in emerging markets have recently preferred American assets, which now yield higher returns. Emerging market countries, which earlier benefited from the easing of monetary conditions in the West, are now feeling the pain of a return to monetary policy normalcy.

The chief among the troubles of emerging market economies is higher domestic inflation when compared to the economies in the West. It is only natural, then, that their currencies will slide in value over time against the dollar and other major Western currencies. There should be a drastic change in emerging market monetary policy vis-à-vis the West

Emerging market currencies are under pressure and this has weighed on the rupee too. The dollar index continues to remain higher on expectations of aggressive interest rate hike by the Federal Reserve. The RBI had not been intervening aggressively to defend the rupee, which has depreciated more than 9% against the dollar in 2018. Comments from officials from the government and quasi-government agencies give the impression that they support this fall in the rupee's value in the interests of competitiveness

The depreciation has implications for exporters, importers and borrowers in foreign exchange. This momentum could dissipate if not reverse suddenly and the way to 'play' the rupee market in the near term is through continuous monitoring of this momentum bias.

The fall also weighed on the equity markets. Trend appears weak for rupee. Sizeable RBI intervention can help avoid panic in market. Month-end dollar demand from importers and the recent rise in oil prices have spurred the trend. The trend forward for the rupee, which has been spiraling downward recently, looks weak, according to currency traders. Dealers also urged higher intervention by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) to help avoid panic-triggered trades.

The rupee needs more support from the RBI or, some big global positive news. There is a lot of panic buying amongst importers and equity investors as well, who want to hedge the currency risk now. Everyone is a buyer of dollars in the current market. The rupee, which has depreciated is the worst-performing Asian currency so far.

The fall in the currency also weighed on the stock market. Most of the index constituents from the lending space such as IndusInd Bank, Yes Bank, Axis Bank, Kotak Bank, HDFC and HDFC Bank lost ground in an overall subdued trading session.
